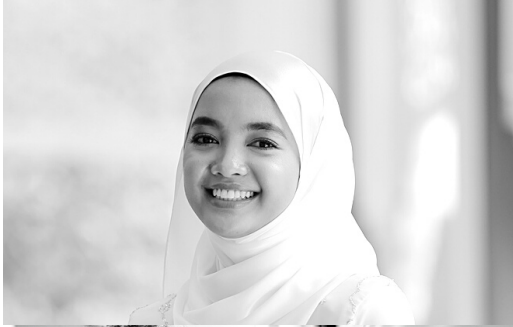

Sola David Borha



Sola is currently a PhD candidate at SOAS, University of London. Prior to this, she served as Standard Bank Group's Africa Regions Chief Executive looking after 19 countries. Sola's extensive career in the financial services industry spanned over 30 years. She currently sits as a NED on the boards of Standard Bank Group's subsidiaries in Nigeria and Uganda. She was Chief Executive of Stanbic IBTC Holdings until January 2017 having also been Chief Executive Stanbic IBTC Bank.

She is currently an Independent NED on the board of Coca-Cola HBC AG and has previously served as Vice Chairman for the Nigerian Economic Summit Group, and served on boards of subsidiaries of the Stanbic IBTC and Standard Bank Groups.

Sola holds an MBA from Manchester Business School, a BSc in Economics from the University of Ibadan, Nigeria and attended the Harvard Advanced Management Programme (AMP) Business School and global CEO program (IESE, Wharton, CEIBS). She is an honorary fellow of the Chartered Institute of Bankers of Nigeria (CIBN). Sola was named Business Woman of the Year for Africa at the CNBC All Africa Business Leaders Awards in 2016.

Ms. Pullinger is the Chief Executive Officer of 100 Women in Finance.
